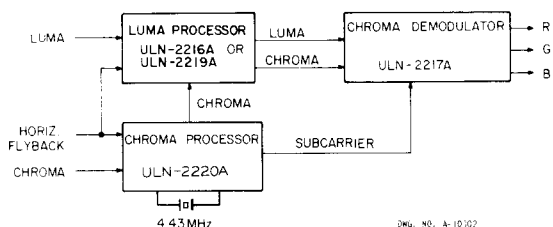

SPECIFICALLY INTENDED for use in color TV receivers utilizing the PAL system, the ULX-2220A/TDA3950A chroma processor is comprised of a crystal reference oscillator, an automatic phase control (APC) loop, an automatic chroma control (ACC) system, a color killer, and PAL identification.

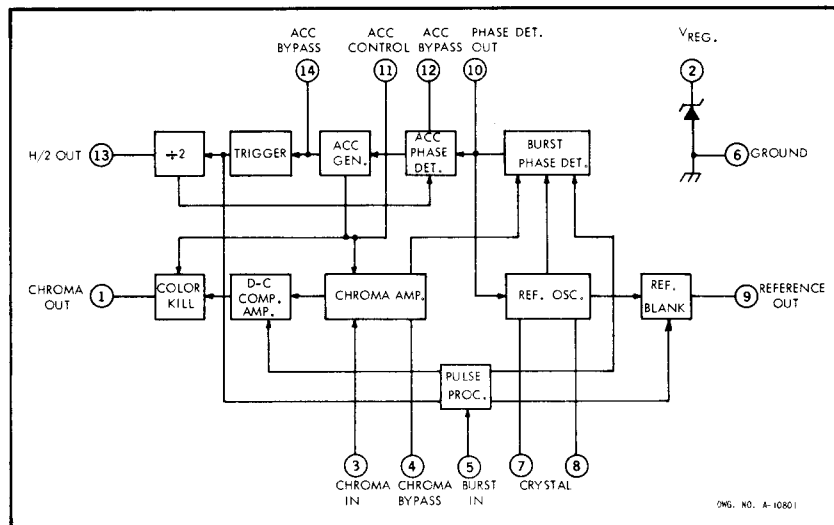
Separate internal voltage regulators prevent coupling between the chroma, burst, and reference oscillator signals and provide consistent operation despite power line voltage fluctuations. Balanced phase detectors provide excellent performance in the presence of large amounts of noise.
